



"Pen Pusher" is inspired by the alienating working world which leads man to such estrangement to prevent him to recognize himself – a traditional way to conceive work leading to widespread dissatisfaction.

The old office settings are the background, typical of Lars Tumbjork's photographic projects, with cold furnishings with clean lines, labyrinths of spaces and meeting rooms in which only the irrepressible non-conformism of human nature can give a vital breath to urban lifestyle otherwise barren. An extremely serious and static world, evoked in the project through the volumes and typical cuts of old personal computers and mouse, main characters of an informatics revolution, considered necessary by society, which nonetheless, over the years, has hindered daily life and interfered with natural human interactions.
