






### MOOD BOARD




### FINAL SKETCH





### SELECTED LOOK

#### **Description**

For my selected look, I want to portray Tokusatsu influence by using oversized silhouette, material combination and texture. The key item is a mixed leather oversized blazer, an oversized silhouette reminiscent of the over scale of filming technique and gigantic size character in tokusatsu series. Moreover, the combination of two types of leather which is suede leather and glossy leather adds more depth and dimension to the blazer. I also want to create a new texture to the leather by using an aligned seam on both sleeves for a various surface.

For the shorts, I want to create everyday shorts by using a simple design but twisted with bold color to express the bold personality. Last but not least, I link legging with the blazer by using an aligned seam into the pattern that is inspired by the Tokusatsu series. In conclusion, I chose this look because it is the best look that expresses both my interest and my style in fashion. I truly hope that this collection can connect to anyone who is still shy to express their real personality by giving them courage through playful creativity and bold style.






