Crafted from torn discarded leather and secondhand jackets, the Ozen Revival Leather collection is a bold statement piece born from waste. It features hand-stitched holes — each one symbolizing the scars of fast fashion and environmental neglect.

Used Leather, Kitenge for lining, YKK sippers, Beads


The collection is designed for conscious, style-forward individuals—men—who value heritage craftsmanship, sustainable fashion, and timeless, unisex design.

Collection, Sorting, and Processing – Hands of Change

Garments rescued from waste streams undergo an artisanal regeneration process in community-led hubs. Each piece is handsorted by leather type, texture, and design potential, then carefully cleaned using specialized, non-abrasive methods. After assessing structural integrity, the materials are deconstructed and prepared for transformation—merging technical precision with purposeful craftsmanship.







Intricate beadingadding a distinctive edge that celebrates heritage, craftsmanship, and cultural artistry.







