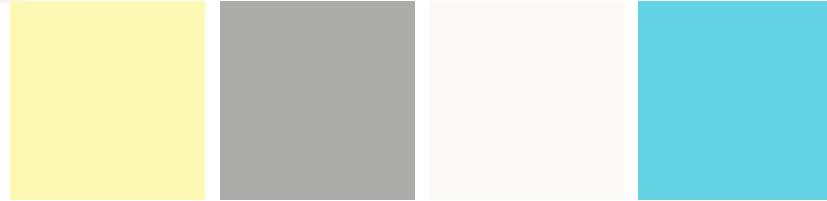

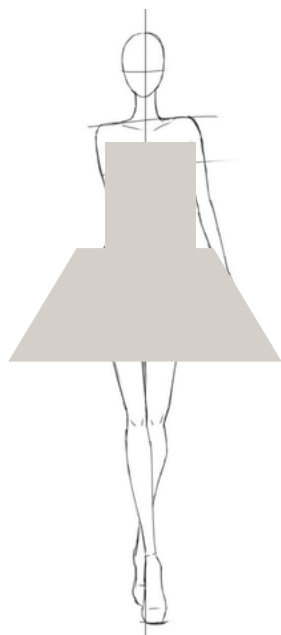

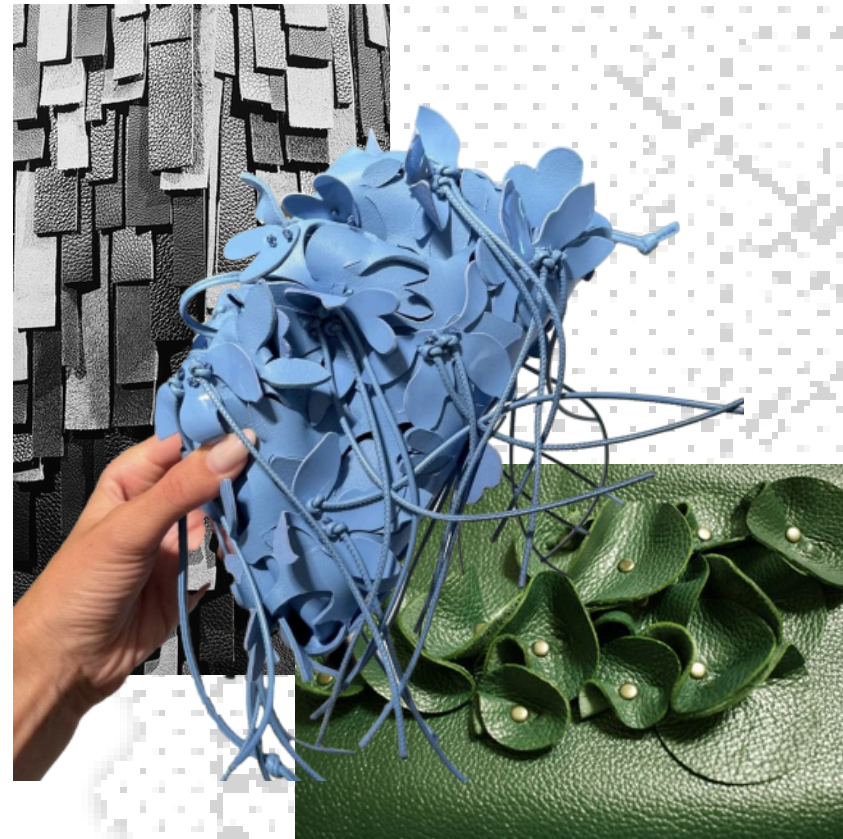


- Cow leather
